Subject:- **Filling up of the AYUSH/BPT seats in the Government/Private Colleges – online counselling thereof.**
Reference:- Notice No. 78-BOPEE of 2018 dated 28-08-2018

Notification No. 098-BOPEE of 2018 Dated 29-08-2018

Whereas, vide Notice No. 78-BOPEE of 2018 dated 28-08-2018 the list of such candidates, who had not registered earlier for preparation of State Merit List for admission to MBBS/BDS/AYUSH Courses and did not figure in the State Merit List notified vide Notification No. 057-BOPEE of 2018 dated 23-06-2018 but registered in pursuance of Notice No. 069-BOPEE of 2018 dated 04-08-2018 read with other notices was notified; and

Whereas, the Board has decided to call all the eligible candidates for online filling up of preferences out of the candidates figuring in the Provisional State Merit List notified vide Notification No. 57-BOPEE of 2018 dated 23-06-2018 and Notice No. 78-BOPEE of 2018 dated 28-08-2018 for admission to AYUSH/BPT Courses, 2018 and accordingly, online counselling will start w.e.f. **31-08-2018 to 07-09-2018**, which shall include initial one days time for conducting mock exercise for training purposes.

Now, therefore, the eligible and willing candidates, as per the Annexure 'A' to Notification No.057-BOPEE of 2018 dated 23-06-2018 read with Notice No. 78-BOPEE of 2018 dated 28-08-21018 are hereby informed as under:-

IMPORTANT

1. Commencement of online for counselling w.e.f. 31-08-2018 to 07-09-2018;
2. Conduct of mock exercise on 31-08-21018;
3. Actual filling up of preferences w.e.f. 01-09-2018 to 07-09-2018;
4. Last date of payment of fee 07-09-2018 (mid night);
5. Reservation shall be applicable in Government Ayurveda College, Jammu;
6. The cut off score for Open Merit candidates is 119 and for reserved category candidates other than JKPM/CDP/Sports category candidates is 96. The cut off score for Private Colleges is 119.



1) That they are advised in their own interest to go through the instructions contained in the e-Brochure for submitting the online preference forms. However, summary of the instructions is as under:-

- a) The online preference forms can be filled in by going to the BOPEE website (www.jkbopee.gov.in) in this regard, by following the procedures and processes as contained in the Brochure. For facilitation of the candidates the technical and other instructions for online counselling are annexed with this Notification as Annexure 'A' which shall be available on the BOPEE website only. In case of any difficulty they can contact the officials of the BOPEE at the below mentioned numbers or can approach the BOPEE office in person for facilitation. They can also avail the facility of filling up the online preference forms from the National Informatics Centres at District Headquarters or from any Khidmat Centre on payment of charges as notified by the Government from time to time:-

- b) The candidate should select his/her most preferred preference first along with the college of preference followed by 2nd, 3rd, 4th and so on and so forth;
- c) At least one preference shall be required to be filled by the candidate;
- d) Further for any clarification also the candidate can approach the Board Office/above contact numbers;
- e) The candidates who have not deposited the fee earlier at the time of NEET UG, MBBS/BDS counseling shall have to deposit an online fee of Rs.1500/- through credit card/debit card/e-banking before submitting the preferences. The candidates, who do not make the online fee shall not be eligible for further consideration;
- f) The candidates as indicated in Notification No. 057-BOPEE of 2018 dated 23-06-2018 read with Notice No. 78-BOPEE of 2018 and whose documents are deficient shall in no case be eligible for filling up of the online preference forms except in terms of the conditions of the said Notification/Notice, as they shall be required to submit the deficient documents in person in the Board Office at Jammu/Srinagar before their request for allowing them to participate in counseling is considered. Besides such candidates, if any, who do not fall in the cut off merit for OM and reserved categories shall also not be eligible for online counselling/filling up of preferences forms;
- g) Mere filling up of the online preference by the candidates shall not confer any right upon him/her to be considered for seat allotment in the Government/Private AYUSH/BPT Colleges, which shall and shall be determined on the basis of his/her actual eligibility in accordance with the rules and procedures as notified from time to time read with information contained in the Information Brochure, 2018. The admission against the

seats shall be made strictly on the basis of merit-cum-preference read with J&K reservation rules in the Government College of Ayurveda, Jammu and other rules on the subject as notified from time to time;

- h) On 31-08-2018, the candidates can conduct mock exercise to acquaint themselves with the procedures/processes for filling up the online preference forms, as indicated above ;
- i) During these processes, the candidates can amend the preferences as many times as they wish as the purpose is only to facilitate the candidates with the procedures. They can upload all the preferences and fill up the same repeatedly. This will be a practical session.
- j) The actual filling up of the preference forms shall commence from 01-09-2018 upto 07-09-2018 midnight;
- k) The candidates after locking the preferences/making the payment cannot modify the preferences unless they approach the Board Offices at Srinagar/Jammu and are permitted to do so by the Board. Time for deposition of the online fee of **Rs.1500/-** shall be upto 7th September, 2018 midnight after which no fee shall be accepted by the system. The fee can be paid online through credit card, debit card/e-banking, etc;
- l) Since the Board follows common counseling for Government/Private Colleges/Institutions for BAMS/BUMS/BPT Courses, therefore, the candidates should indicate the choice/preference accordingly for Government/Private Colleges/Courses; and
- m) The candidate shall be personally responsible for filling in of any wrong information and Board shall have no liability on this account.

Important:-

The cut off merit for Open Merit candidates and reserved category candidates shall be 119 and 96 respectively. However, in respect of Private Colleges, since there is no reservation, the cut off merit shall be upto 119

As of now no admission is being made in Jammu Institute of Ayurveda & Research, Jammu in light of communication dated 13-08-2018 from the Ministry of AYUSH, wherein it has been desired not to make admissions in the said college till further communication from the Ministry. However, the Board shall take appropriate view on the matter only after receipt of communication from the Ministry.

The candidates whose documents are deficient should approach the BOPEE Office along with such documents so that their cases are considered on merits and allowed to participate in the counseling only after submission of the deficient documents.

The tentative seat matrix shall be available on the BOPEE website www.jkbopee.gov.in which is however, subject to changes depending upon the decision of the Board.

The seats under P&B category in private colleges shall not be filled up during the first round of counseling, therefore, candidates belonging to P&B category shall be considered along with other candidates during this round of counseling. The P&B seats shall, however, be filled up during the 2nd round of counseling or as per the schedule as may be notified by the Board.

The conditions not mentioned hereinabove but otherwise notified by the Board through various Notifications/Notices on the subject will be applicable to the counseling/admission process.

Since the candidates from the State Merit List notified vide Notification No. 057-BOPEE of 2018 dated 23-06-2018 are also eligible along with those notified vide Notice No. 78-BOPEE of 2018 dated 28-08-2018, therefore, the NEET rank will determine the inter-se rank of the candidates.

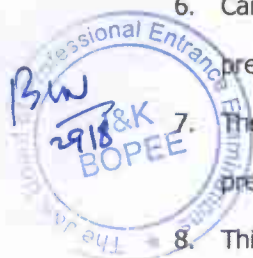

Instructions for submitting online Preference Form

1. Candidates are advised, in their own interest, to go through the Instructions contained therein before actually submitting the online Preference Form
2. BOPEE is seeking Preferences from such candidates who have qualified for NEET UG, 2018 and have been asked to fill in the Preference Form online only
3. The online Preference Form enables a candidate to fill in the preferences for various disciplines/institutions for allotment of a seat for admission in Ayush/BPT courses, 2018 in Government Institutions/ Private College as the case may be.
4. **Candidates need to login into the application using the same username and password which was used while filling up of registration form.**
5. During the online filling up of Preference Form, the candidates will get all the details of the courses available viz-a-viz the institutions.
6. Candidate should select his/her most preferred preference first along with the College of preference followed by second, third, fourth and so on for the said course.
7. The second preference for the course shall be given by the candidate by choosing the college preference as above.
8. This preference shall be available till all the preferences/ colleges are exhausted by the candidate
9. Candidate will be required to fill up at least one preference for a course/college and without entering any preference the candidate will not be able to proceed further
10. Candidates can modify the preferences selected by them till such time they do not finally submit/lock the Preference Form, after which the candidate will not be able to modify the same
11. **The candidate shall have to deposit a Fee of Rs. 1500 online and after locking the preferences. However those candidates who have deposited their fee during NEET UG MBBS/BDS 2018 counseling need not to pay online fee again.**
12. Candidates will get sufficient time to fill in the Preference Form and should not be in a hurry while filling up the Form. This system has been evolved to facilitate candidates to fill in the form online without approaching the BOPEE office in person.



13. Candidates who have submitted the form online shall, however, be required to download/print at least one copy of the Preference Form for retention by the candidate.

14. Candidates should remain in touch with the BOPEE website for update, if any, in this regard

15. For further information please see the Technical information as under:

1. Please read the instructions carefully.

2. Submitting Preferences:

- a. Candidate must lock the preferences before the last date; candidates will not be able to lock their choices after the last date.
- b. Click on "Subject" link after logging in.
- c. Select course candidate wants to apply and then click on "Select" button.
- d. Selected course available in the college will be shown in the "disciplines available box"
- e. Candidates are advised to select course as per their preferences from "disciplines available box" and clicking on ">>" button to set their preferences, course chosen will be shown in the "disciplines assigned box" with preference selected.
- f. If a candidate wants to remove the preference he/she can do so by selecting the preference from "disciplines assigned box" and clicking on "<<" button.
- g. Preferences select by the candidate will be saved automatically; candidate will get the operations performed by him/her whenever he/she logs in to the Application.
- h. Candidate can also see the preview of the preferences selected by him/her by clicking on "Preview" button and can also take the print out of the same for their perusal.
- i. Candidate can add and delete preferences anytime but before last date and before locking their preferences.
- j. If candidate wants to lock his/her choices, click on "Submit" button; a preview of choices will be shown and if he/she is satisfied with his/her preferences locked him/her then by clicking on "Submit" button the Preview Page of selected choices will be locked.
- k. Once a candidate locks his choices then no modification can be done in the preferences selected.**



- l. Candidates will be given the option to "make payment" of fee online only after the choices are locked, Fee must be paid before the last date of fee submission.
- m. Candidates can submit fee after locking their choices and clicking on subject tab.
- n. Only those Applications will be accepted having choices locked and have fee submitted on time, Applications failing this criteria will be rejected.

3. Making Fee Payment:

- a. Fee will only be paid online before the last date of fee submission.
- b. Fee payment option will be given only after candidate locks his/her preferences.
- c. Click on "make payment" button, candidate will be redirected to Payment Page and make payment by choosing any available option.
- d. Payment Receipt will be generated after payment is successful.
- e. Candidate can take print out of the payment receipt.

4. Password forgotten:

- a. Candidate can reset password of their account by going to login page clicking on "Forget Password" link, after entering StudentID and Date of Birth and Email will be sent to the email ID of the candidate
- b. Click on the link in the mail, candidate can now set new password.
