Subject :- Implementation of 10% EWS quota in PG courses in Government Medical Colleges for the academic year 2020-21- Forwarding of BoG-MIC's letter dated 29-04-2020- Regarding.

Whereas, proposals were forwarded by the Medical Colleges/Institutions of Union Territory of J&K to the Medical Council of India for grant of permission for increase of seats under EWS category; and

Whereas, the Board of Governors, Medical Council of India has considered the proposals of the UT of J&K and approved the proposal in conformity with the PGMER regulations; and

Whereas, 50 PG seats were recommended to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India vide communication No. MCI-23(I)(EWS)/2020-Med./100149 dated 29-04-2020 by the MCI, the details of college-wise PG seats in respect of UT of J&K are as under:-

Whereas, these additional increased seats under EWS category are **not overall increase but increased in few disciplines/streams as annexed "A"** and were not received by the Board at the time of conduct of first round of online counselling for which the admissions have closed on 11-05-2020; and

Whereas, amendments in the Reservation Act of 2004 have been carried out vide Re-organization Act of 2019 as enacted by the Parliament, which are effective from 31-10-2019. Besides, provision for reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) has also been provided vide SRO 518 of 2019 dated 02-09-2019, which SRO shall be operative during

the year 2020-21 and vide the said SRO, the Government has also notified the procedures for issuance of certificates to the EWS by the prescribed Competent Authorities; and

Whereas, the Board advised the candidates willing to compete against the quota as may be permissible for EWS out of the increase in intake for the above colleges to have their certificates prepared in accordance with the law so that the additional unfilled seats are filled up during the second round of counselling; and

Whereas, the Board has decided to fill up additional seats accordingly and in this regard it is hereby notified as under:-

1. The tentative seat matrix for the additional seats for three Medical Colleges/Institutions as mentioned above is annexed as Annexure 'A' to this Notification.
2. The candidates who shall be in possession of valid EWS certificate issued by the Competent Authority as prescribed by law in pursuance of SRO 518 dated 02-09-2019 shall have to produce the same in original along with self-attested copy of the same in the BOPEE Office at Jammu / Srinagar at the time of counseling. The certificates issued should bear a reference of SRO 518 of 2019 dated 02-09-2019. Incomplete certificates or the certificates issues without reference of SRO 518 of 2019 shall not be entertained.
3. The Board shall conduct the counseling for filling up of the available seats under EWS and those under Reserve Categories etc. as a consequence of the increased capacity of the above colleges and such seats as may become available as a consequence of allotment / upgradation, if any, in the Board Office Jammu / Srinagar simultaneously on the dates shall be notified separately.
4. The other unfilled seats as a consequence of the above including those if any in ASCOMS shall also be filled during the 2nd round of physical counseling.
5. The candidates willing to participate in the counseling for consideration for allotment of seat, if any, in ASCOMS shall have to take a conscious decision and satisfy the Board about their ability to pay the fee to the college and in case of non-joining by the candidates after admission, Board reserves the right to initiate action against such candidates as the seats cannot be allowed to go waste merely because the candidates have not joined the college/ course allotted to them.
6. The seats shall be allotted to the candidates on the basis of merit cum preference on their turn.

Following shall be eligible:-

- (a) All eligible candidates under EWS who have obtained certificates under SRO 518 of 2019 dated 02-09-2019.
- (b) EWS seats shall be filled up in the three Government Medical Colleges / Institution viz. GMC, Jammu, GMC, Srinagar and SKIMS, Soura Srinagar where the intake capacity has been increased.
- (c) The distribution of the EWS seats shall be made as per the distribution made under rules.

- (d) The EWS merit, in those disciplines / Streams where intake under EWS category is increased, shall start after the cut of merit of the open merit candidates who have been allotted seats earlier
- (e) Additional seats in the reserved categories shall be filled up as a consequence of increase of intake by allotment / upgradation of eligible category candidates.
- (f) The candidates who have been allotted seats in ASCOMS and now in position of EWS certificate shall also be eligible to compete against the EWS quota seats in three Medical Colleges / Institutions.
- (g) Resultant seat(s), if any, in ASCOMS shall also be filled up through common counseling on the basis of merit cum preference from amongst the eligible and willing candidates.
- (h) Any seat which remained unfilled as a consequence of above in Government / Private Colleges shall also be filled up through common counseling.

Following shall not be eligible:-

- (a) Rule 17 will not apply in the second Round of counseling.

NOTE:-

1. Admissions so made under EWS category shall be provisional and if Board receives any complaint about the genuineness of EWS category certificate of any candidate (s), the Board after verifying it through proper channels and if the verification reveals that the claim to belonging to EWS is fake / false the selection will be terminated forthwith without assigning any further reasons and without prejudice to such further action as may be necessary under the provisions of the Law as applicable in the UT of Jammu and Kashmir.
2. In order to ensure that the admission process is completed in time bound manner and within the cutoff date, the candidates shall be required to join the college within the prescribed time limit to be notified in the allotment / upgradation notification.
3. The candidates shall have to report in the BOPEE Office at 09:00 AM. for registration, attendance and subsequent counseling on the dates to be notified separately. No proxy shall be permitted.

The general conditions shall remain the same as notified in the Information Brochure and the Notifications and Notices issued from time to time on the subject.
