Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the Jammu Institute of Ayurved & Research, Nardhani Raipur, Ban Talab Road, Jammu Tawi, 181123 Jammu & Kashmir” with 90 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats 03 PG courses namely (i) Kayachikitsa- 05 seats (ii) Shalya Tantra -05 seats & (iii) Kriya Sharir - 05 seats for the academic session 2019-20 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970- reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to Ministry's order no. L-14014/65/2019-EP(1) dated 04.07.2019 wherein your college was denied permission to conduct 90 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats 03 PG courses namely (i) Kayachikitsa- 05 seats (ii) Shalya Tantra -05 seats & (iii) Kriya Sharir - 05 seats for the academic session 2019-20 after examining CCIM's recommendation vide letter No.26-38/2019-College. dated 30.04.2019.

2. In this regard it is stated that CCIM vide its letter no.26-38/2019-College. dated 21.05.2019 has sent revised recommendation to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that the said college is fulfilling the norms for granting conditional permission (permission for a period of one year) for the academic year 2019-20, as per sub-regulation (3) of regulation 3 of RMS, 2016, IMCC Post graduate (Ayurveda) regulations, 2016 and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs).

3. Accordingly, it has been decided by the Central Government to grant conditional permission to Jammu Institute of Ayurved & Research, Nardhani Raipur, Ban Talab Road, Jammu Tawi, 181123 Jammu & Kashmir with 90 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses namely (i) Kayachikitsa- 05 seats (ii) Shalya Tantra -05 seats & (iii) Kriya Sharir - 05 seats for the academic session 2019-20 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 subject to following conditions:-

i. The college shall submit an undertaking in form of affidavit duly notarized within one month from the date of issue of this letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

ii. The colleges shall submit undertaking in the form of Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers/Hospital Clinical Staff/Consultant in concerned State Boards/Council where the college/hospital is located or Central Registration of the CCIM by

31st December, 2019 as per the decisions conveyed vide letters 22.03.2019 & 22.04.2019 by CCIM and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant/denial of permission for the academic year 2020-21.

4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.

5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCIM and the Central Government.

6. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2019 to get conditional permission for the session 2020-21:


- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*; and
- (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.

6. The fulfillment of the above mentioned conditions will be verified by the CCIM by means of an inspection and CCIM will submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2020-21.

7. Earlier denied order issued vide letter no. L-14014/65/2019-EP(1) dated 04.07.2019 stands withdrawn.

8. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
